



Brian Epstein (1934-1967) was the manager who discovered the Beatles and helped them make it big. Thanks to him, they were attracting international attention when they were still very young.



George Martin (1926-2016) was a studio producer and arranger for most of the Beatles' recordings, and he himself played on many tracks. In the studio, they called him Big George, to distinguish him from George Harrison.



Geoff Emerick (1945-2018) was the sound engineer at Abbey Road studios in the sixties and helped develop the Beatles sound on the albums Revolver, Sgt. Pepper's Lonely Hearts Club Band, the White Album and Abbey Road.
